NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND MONTHLY SUPERVISORS MEETING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Rhine Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, April 13, 2021 at 6:30 PM. The meeting will be held virtually via bluejeans technology.

The purpose of this Public Hearing is to hear public comment on the following requests:

- A. To consider the request of Jeff Ebersole of W4637 County Rd. EH, Elkhart Lake, WI 53020 to rezone his property located on County Rd. A, ¼ mile west of Highway 57, from A1 to A2. Parcels are 59018256800 (20 acres) and 59018256790 (40 acres). The plan commission recommended denial of the request.
- B. To consider the request of Peter and Alice Schaff of 1034 Chestnut Avenue, Wilmette, IL 60091 to rezone property at W6654 county Road A North, Elkhart Lake, WI 53020 from A1 to A5 for 12 acres of parcel 59018258791. The remaining 39.63 acres would remain zoned as A1. The plan commission recommended approval of the request based on the condition that the approval is contingent upon finalizing the sale of said property to the Schaffs.
- C. To conduct a public hearing and consider a resolution declaring that it is in the public interest to discontinue (vacate) a portion of a Laretta Court and unimproved alleys in Schwaller's Second Plat.
- D. To consider the following boating regulations concerning Crystal Lake, an inland lake within the Towns of Rhine and Plymouth, Sheboygan County, pursuant to Wis. Stats. s. 30.77(3)(a), (ac)2 and (aw): An ordinance to prohibit artificial wake enhancement boating equipment and operation on Crystal Lake.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Town of Rhine Board of Supervisors will consider approval of the above at the regular Monthly Supervisors Meeting to be held immediately following the Public Hearing.
